





Egypt: Visas are required and are included in your tour cost unless otherwise indicated for arrival at Cairo Airport.

Israel: As of January 2025, travelers to Israel must have a valid visa or the Electronic Travel Authorization to Israel (ETA-IL) approval before starting their journey. It is recommended that the application should be completed prior to

purchasing your tickets. If you are a citizen of a visa-exempt country, please go on-line to: Israel-entry.piba.gov.il to fill out the application which also requires a fee.

Passport must be valid at least 6 months from time of arrival in the UAE, together with a confirmed round-trip airline ticket or airline ticket to other destinations.
