ITINERARY

Thursday: En Route

Depart the U.S.A. on your flight to Israel.

Friday: Tel Aviv

Welcome to Israel! Arrive Ben Gurion Airport; special meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel in trendy Tel Aviv's Mediterranean beach. Balance of the afternoon at leisure in the "city that never sleeps". Tonight, **Get Together Dinner**. (D)

Saturday: Tel Aviv

Morning walking tour through the city's well known streets including Dizengoff Square ending at **Ben Gurion House**, former residence of the First Prime Minister. Remainder of the day at leisure to enjoy all of the delights of this Mediterranean paradise. Tel Aviv's museums and restaurants are world-class. Don't miss Tel Aviv's hip port neighborhood, with its yachts, eateries and café-filled boardwalk. (B)

Sunday: Tel Aviv/Haifa

Depart Tel Aviv. Drive to the extraordinary **Israeli Museum** at the **Yitzhak Rabin Center** chronicling the life of the late Prime Minister and the development of the State of Israel. Continue to ancient **Caesarea**; explore the Roman and Crusader ruins including the impressive 2,000-year-old theater (still in use!) and aqueduct. Arrive in **Nazareth**, the sacred town where Jesus spent part of his youth; visit the Church and view **Mary's Well**. On to the sparkling port city of **Haifa**; check into your hotel

atop Mt. Carmel. Evening: Enjoy **Dinner** and a special cultural presentation (*subject to minimum 10 tour participants*). (B,D)

Monday: Haifa

Begin the day with a view of the golden-domed **Baha'i Shrine** and visit the breathtaking "**hanging gardens**," – a UNESCO World Heritage site. Drive along the coast to **Rosh Hanikra**; descend by cable car to see the magnificent underwater grottoes. Time to enjoy some **fine wines** at a local winery. Then, continue to the timeless Crusader city of **Acre**; walk through the subterranean city and bazaars that recall the colorful middle Ages. Return to Haifa for an evening at leisure in the picturesque **German Colony**, with its great dining options and special ambiance. Your guide and driver will be available to assist with transportation to this charming neighborhood. (B)

Tuesday: Haifa/Jerusalem

Depart Haifa en route to **Safed**, one of Judaism's holiest cities, where the Kabbalah was developed in the 16th-century; visit the ancient synagogues and the charming Artists' Quarter. On to **Capernaum**, by the Sea of Galilee; see the fantastic ruins of the ancient 5th-century synagogue. Continue through the southern Golan Heights to visit a former Syrian army bunker at Kibbutz Kfar Charuv, settled by Americans and Israelis together; view the fertile valleys below as you tour the kibbutz and enjoy lunch. We'll then have a thrilling afternoon as we

board our Jeeps and ascend the strategic **Golan Heights** to learn about the 20th century battles that protected Israel's future. We'll stop at the Syrian Officers' Club and hear the story of Israel's most famous Mossad spies, Eli Cohen "Our man in Damascus". Then drive south and rise through the mountains to "golden" Jerusalem, stopping first for a blessing and a toast to our arrival in the eternal city. Overnight in Israel's capital. (B.L)

Wednesday: Jerusalem

Drive to **Hadassah Medical Center** to see the sublime **Chagall Windows**. On to **Yad Vashem**, Israel's national Memorial and Museum of the Holocaust, with its Children's Pavilion and Avenue of the Righteous. Then, to **Mount Herzl** to pay respects to Israel's founders and heroes. Pass the post-modern **Supreme Court** and the **Knesset** (Parliament) en route to the **Shrine of the Book**, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Time to walk through the **Israel Museum** and the **Billy Rose Sculpture Garden**; see the **Scale Model** of ancient Jerusalem. Evening: **Night Tour** of illuminated Jerusalem followed by a **Restaurant Dinner** and the "Night Spectacular" **Sound & Light Show** at the **Citadel Museum** (weather and schedule permitting). (B.D)

Thursday: Jerusalem

Drive to **Mt. Zion** to visit the traditional **Tomb of King David** and the **Room of the Last Supper**. Enter the **Old City** to the restored **Jewish Quarter**; walk along the **Cardo**, the colonnaded main street of Byzantine Jerusalem. Walk to the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the Second Temple. View the **Dome of the Rock**. Proceed through the extraordinary **Hasmonean Tunnel** (tunnel schedule permitting) or tour the **Herodian Mansions**, a completely excavated residential quarter from 2000 years ago. Follow the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**; stroll through the exotic **bazaars** with their wondrous aromas. This afternoon at leisure for relaxation and strolling the neighborhoods of Jerusalem. Or, an *optional* visit to **Bethlehem** may be arranged. A free night tonight. The shops are open late as it's the start of the Israeli weekend. Enjoy the many eateries along the outdoor **Mamilla Mall**, **Ben Yehuda Street**, or the "Tachana". (B)

Friday: Jerusalem

Descend through the Judean desert to the **Dead Sea**, lowest point on Planet Earth. Ascend **Masada** by cable car and see this last stronghold of the Zealots in their struggle against the Romans. Visit the excavations, Herod the Great's palace, synagogue and bathhouse. Then, opportunity to enjoy an "unsinkable" swim in the buoyant waters of the **Dead Sea**. Drive via the **Qumran Caves**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, on your return to Jerusalem. We'll stop at the **Western Wall** on this Sabbath eve before arriving to the hotel (*time permitting*). Tonight, enjoy the traditional **Friday dinner** together. (B.D)

Saturday: Jerusalem

Enjoy a full day at leisure for relaxation and on your own exploration. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

Sunday: Jerusalem/Petra

Morning transfer from your hotel in Jerusalem to the **Allenby/King Hussein Bridge**. Our representative meets your vehicle at the Terminal Building on the Israeli Side of the Border and will attend to all required procedures at this crossing and escorts you to the awaiting vehicle to begin your tour of Jordan; an **Exclusive Isram service** (no waiting for shuttle buses!). Meet your Jordanian guide and begin your drive through the dramatic desert scenery of the **Kings Highway**. First stop is the **Byzantine Church of Mt. Nebo** where Moses viewed the **Promised Land**. Enjoy the breathtaking view of the **Jordan Valley** and the **Dead Sea** where, in March 2000, Pope Paul II planted an olive tree as a symbol for peace. Then proceed to **Madaba**, Byzantine Center of master mosaics; see the oldest surviving mosaic map of the Holyland. After lunch, visit the dramatic crusader castle of **Kerak**, a maze of stone vaulted halls and endless passageways. Arrive in **Petra**, built by the Nabateans over 2000 years ago. Dinner and overnight in Petra. (B.L.D)

Monday: Petra/Amman

A most unforgettable day! Your guide will take you on a tour into the 'hidden' city of Petra. UNESCO has described it as 'one of the most precious cultural properties of man's cultural heritage. Start the visit with a horse ride, or if you prefer, an exhilarating walk from the main gate of Petra to the beginning of the "Siq". Continue by foot to visit the **rose-red city of Petra** - City of the Edomites and later the Nabateans who

carved a breathtaking empire out of the solid mountain rock hidden by a canyon. You will visit the Treasury made famous in the movie "Indiana Jones"; see the **Theatre Tombs**, **Hall of Justice**, **Palaces and Temples**. After lunch, depart Petra and drive north to Amman. Check in to your hotel for overnight. (B.L)

Tuesday: Amman/Jerash/Ajloun/Israel (Ben Gurion Airport)

Begin with a tour of **Amman**, the capital of Jordan known as **Rabbath Ammon** and **Philadelphia** in Biblical times. See the **Roman Theatre** and the **Citadel** containing the remains of the massive **Temple of Hercules**. Then, travel north to the city of **Jerash**, the "Pompeii of the East" which is perhaps, the best preserved of the provincial Roman towns. Known as the city of a 1,000 Pillars, its historical monuments cover a time span of more than 5,000 years. Around its colonnaded main street, see the **Cardo**, **South Theatre**, **Temple of Zeus**, **Hadrian's Arch**, the **Artemis Temple** and the **Nymphaeum**. The city's 14 churches date from Byzantine time and are filled with fine mosaics. If time permits, on to **Ajloun** and the **Arab Castle** from where the forces of **Salahedin (Saladin)** launched their campaigns against the Crusader. Enjoy a late afternoon lunch before continuing to the border between Jordan and Israel - **Sheikh Hussein**. Cross to Israel and transfer to **Ben Gurion Airport** for your late evening flight; special assistance is provided for check-in services. (B.L)
